RAD UPDATE

Fall is arriving, and that means we are almost ready to close on the RAD conversion. We expect to settle all the loans, grants, etc. in mid-November, so rehab should begin on December 1, 2020. At this point in time, we plan to start rehab in Pennyrile Homes. I do not know which buildings at this time, but will let you know as soon as the construction company lets me know. It is a good time for you to declutter your unit and get rid of those items you no longer need. It will make it a lot easier to move when your time comes. You will be notified by Rebecca Walker when it is time for you to move, so make sure property managers have your correct phone number. If you have changed phone numbers lately, please call the office and let them know your new number. You will be given boxes to box up your belongings. A moving company will then come in to load your boxes and your furniture and move them into your new unit. They will not be assisting you with filling the boxes. All expenses such as moving cable, telephone, etc. will be taken care of by us. If you have specific questions, please feel free to reach out to me. I should be able to send out a construction schedule by November 1st.

Housing Authority Happenings

Payments and Account Balances

Please keep in mind, <u>rent must be paid by the 10th</u> of every month. If we haven't received the rent payment by the 10th of each month, there will be a <u>\$30 late fee</u> applied to the account. Please make sure all electric/gas/work order charges are paid by the end of each month. When you are making payments to the Housing Authority, **please write your name and address clearly on the money order or check**. If we cannot clearly read your name, then we are unable to post it to your account.

Eviction Notices

We will be sending 30-Day eviction notices to anyone who owes rent **past the 10th day of** each month. If you receive a 30-Day notice, <u>you must pay your entire account balance in</u> <u>full by the deadline to stop the eviction process.</u>

Recertification

Annual recertifications for **Brooks Village, Rozelle Village, East 4**th, **3**rd, **2**nd, **and Honeysuckle Drive** are now in process. Please check your mailboxes for your recertification packet, and also be aware that you may receive important information in your door via hand delivery, so make sure to check that periodically as well. Please fill out <u>all</u> of the recertification paperwork in its entirety and submit <u>all</u> necessary verification paperwork to the Housing Authority. All recertifications must be completed by December 1st, 2020, to prevent being placed on **Flat Rent**.

PACS

You may be eligible for PACS assistance. PACS is a local community agency offering community services to assist with monthly utility expenses. Pull Herbie Curbies Back

Trash pickup is on <u>Monday</u> for Pennyrile Homes, Waddell, and Honeysuckle. The Herbie Curbie must be moved back no later than <u>Monday at 8:00 pm.</u>


Trash pickup is on <u>Friday</u> for Moore Ct, East Side (Moore Dr, Massey Ln, Dade Ln, Summit St, Spring St, Short St), Rozelle, and 2nd – 4th Street. The Herbie Curbie must be moved back no later than <u>Friday at 8:00 pm.</u>

Charges will continue weekly if the Herbie Curbies are not in their designated storage location.

HOW TO PREPARE FOR TREATMENT BEFORE TECHNICIANS ARRIVE

- Any items on top of the refrigerator or stove will need to be cleared. The stove and refrigerator will be pulled out by the technicians to treat behind the appliances.
- The countertop and stovetop will need to be clear of food and dirty dishes
- Have your apartment clutter free for the technicians to be able to fully treat your unit.

Note: If you are given a letter for a <u>scheduled</u> FOG or Bedbug treatment please follow treatment instructions given to you at that time.

If you cannot pick it up, someone can pick it up for you with a hand written note from the tenant receiving commodities.

If commodities are not picked up for three consecutive months without contacting us with a reason, you will be removed from the program automatically and must re-enroll to receive future commodities. You will be placed on the bottom of the waiting list.

Baked Chicken Nachos



1 Tbsp. oil

3/4 cup water 7 cups tortilla chips (6 oz.) 1 cup each chopped green peppers, red peppers and onions

3 cups shredded cooked chicken breasts

1 pkg. TACO BELL® Taco Seasoning Mix 3/4 cup BREAKSTONE'S or KNUDSEN Sour Cream 1-1/2 cups KRAFT Shredded Pepper Jack Cheese

Heat oven to 350°F.


Trick or Treat <u>Have a fun and a safe Halloween!!!</u>
